

GETTING TO LA VILLA DE MAZAMET

These are the most direct routes to Mazamet from various locations. We suggest printing a copy to aid your journey to us.

Should you like a more scenic route; please let us know from where you will be heading and we will send you the respective route.

THE ROUTES

FROM CALAIS/PARIS

Take the E09/A20 in the Direction of Toulouse. If you are using Sat Nav, it may take you off the E09/A20 signed for Albi and Gaillac, simply follow your sat nav but it is quite a slower, more scenic, route which passes through a number of village with 50 kph speed restrictions. If you are ignoring your sat nav (*or if you are not using one*) **continue onto the E09/A20** and you will reach the **A62/A61** 'périphérique (ring road) around Toulouse, leading onto the **A68 take the first exit after the toll booths, signposted Castres.**

Follow the Mazamet signs along the N126 until you reach a large roundabout with the village of "Soaul" signed to the right on D926; when you pass through the centre of the village, you will take **the first right towards Mazamet on the D621** – follow this road until you arrive at a large set of traffic lights at a 'K' shape junction at the outskirts of Mazamet, with an Aldi supermarket on your left.

Bare right to take the N118, signed for Carcassonne and Centre Ville. This is a long straight road which takes you into central Mazamet. Pass over the railways



line at the traffic lights and you will see the park on your left; rue Pasteur is the first right (*look out for this sign*) – La Villa de Mazamet is on the right. (*see parking information overleaf*)

FROM BARCELONA/PERPIGNAN

Take the **E-15 towards "Franca" (France)** and Perpignan, once you pass Perpignan head for Narbonne, and **exit onto the E80 heading towards Toulouse. Exit the E80 /A61 at Carcassonne (Airport and Zone Industrial)** which is signposted Mazamet – you will **then pick up the D118** which takes you over the Montagne Noire to Mazamet.

You enter into the town from the mountains, after the Mazamet sign, **follow signs for 'Centre Ville'**. Once in the centre of town amongst the banks and shops, you will have to **bare right onto a small one way system** (*you will see the La Gambetta newspaper stand on your right as you go round the bend*), immediately get in the left hand lane and **turn left into 'rue L'Arnette' signposted for Toulouse / Albi / Castres.**

After 250m, at the end of this road, you have to turn left again onto 'rue de Pont de Caville' where you will see a set of traffic lights ahead. **Turn right at these lights (very sharp turn)** onto 'Avenue Albert Rouviere' **signposted Albi / Castres.** After a few metres you will see 'La Poste' (Post Office) on your right, and then the park 'Jardin de Promenades'; **rue Pasteur is the first road on the left** that

you are allowed to turn into, opposite the bandstand in the park (*look out for this sign*). La Villa de Mazamet is the second building on your right.



FROM CARCASSONNE AIRPORT

From the car rental carpark, you will exit onto a main roundabout, **take the direction towards Carcassonne “Centre Ville” on the D33** and you will pass back in front the airport itself – continue until you reach another main roundabout and **take the third exit, signed “Autres Directions” D6161**. Continue on this until you reach a large roundabout (*you will see the supermarket & fuel station “L. Leclerc”*) – **keep following the D6161 (which will become the D6113)** – keep following signs for Mazamet, the road will turn into the **D149** for a short distance before you **turn left onto the D118** which leads all the way to Mazamet, around 40km.

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After 250m, at the end of this road, you have to turn left again onto ‘rue de ‘Pont de Caville’ where you will see a set of traffic lights ahead. **Turn right at these lights (very sharp turn)** onto ‘Avenue Albert Rouviere’ **signposted Albi / Castres**. After a few metres you will see ‘La Poste’ (*Post Office*) on your right, and then the park ‘Jardin de Promenades’; **rue Pasteur is the first road on the left** that you are allowed to turn into, opposite the bandstand in the park (*look out for this sign*). La Villa de Mazamet is the second building on your right.



roundabout and head up the short hill. At the next small roundabout **go straight ahead, then bare right at the next much smaller one**. This takes you up behind the park, after 300 metres you will come to a cross-road with traffic lights; **turn left, signed for Carcassonne & Centre Ville**, and the park will be on your left; rue Pasteur is the first right turn (*look out for the sign pictured here*) – La Villa de Mazamet is on your right.



PARKING ON ARRIVAL AT LA VILLA DE MAZAMET

When you turn into rue Pasteur, you can park on the street directly in front of La Villa (*if the 1st – 15th of the month, park on the left; if the 16th onwards on the right*). Alternatively, turn immediately right at our gates onto “Rue de la Liberation” and park on the left-hand side of this road.

FROM MONTPELLIER/BEZIERS

Head towards Beziers/Perpignan on the E80/E15/A9 exit towards Beziers on the N112/D612 – avoiding heading into the centre of Beziers. The road numbers will remain the same all the way to Mazamet which will be clearly signed and will take approximately 90 mins.

On arriving in Mazamet, you will come to a large roundabout with a McDonald’s on your left. **Take the third exit on this**
